**ORGANISATIONAL SET-UP:**

The Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence & Statistics (DGCIS) is a subordinate office of the Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce and Industry. It is the only organization of its kind located in Kolkata. For about one hundred and fifty years this Directorate is serving the nation relentlessly as the principle source of trade related information in India. The organization is headed by the Director General, an Additional Secretary level officer of the Indian Statistical Service (ISS).

To provide an effective and responsive administration in the field of foreign trade statistics and other information related to trade and commerce.

Dissemination of India's foreign Trade Statistics and Commercial Information and release publications based on such data/statistics through electronic mode in various standard formats. It contains tenders of all Government of India Organizations, State Governments, PSUs and private bodies. It also contains information & news capsules related to India's foreign trade. ## **STANDARD AND QUALITY OF SERVICES:**

It is the consistent endeavour of our organization to deal with our clients in an open and transparent manner and ensure disposal of all applications within the time schedule as prescribed in the policy/procedures. In case of delay, the clients can approach the nodal officer with prior appointment. Cases of inordinate delay where the matter has not been resolved by the nodal officer could be brought to the notice of the Director General of Commercial Intelligence & Statistics for taking remedial measures.
